<ul> <li>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</li> <li>Increasingly follow rules and understand why they are important.</li> <li>Develop their sense of responsibility though small jobs e.g putting cups out for snack.</li> <li>Encourage children to welcome new children into the setting.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Communication and Language</li> <li>Use a wider range of vocabulary.</li> <li>Beginning to understand 2 part instructions.</li> <li>Learn new vocabulary such as: hibernate, nocturnal, seasons, melt, shadow, winter.</li> <li>Understand 'why' and 'how'.</li> </ul>	Physical Development  Children to put on their own coat and shoes and begin to have a go at zips.  Creating their own obstacle courses outside.  Using a knife and fork to scoop.  Making purposeful marks – have plenty of paper and mark making tool available.
<ul> <li>Literacy</li> <li>Compare fiction/non fiction books.</li> <li>Understand the 5 concepts of print, reading from left to right and caring for books appropriately.</li> <li>Listening to longer stories and remembering much of what's happened.</li> <li>Phonics – rhyme and alliteration, listen to animal sounds you might hear at night.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Expressive Arts and Design</li> <li>Winter collage with different textures.</li> <li>Building igloos with sugar cubes.</li> <li>Salt dough hedgehogs</li> <li>Icing sugar painting.</li> <li>Chinese New Year</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Mathematics</li> <li>Compare size e.g owl babies – compare 3 owls and eggs.</li> <li>Matching patterns</li> <li>Look at numbers 1-5.</li> <li>Include numbers in provision.</li> <li>Looking at 2d shapes and making other shapes from putting others together. (creating shadows with these)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Understanding the World</li> <li>Comparing night and day in countries on the opposite side of the world.</li> <li>Investigating shadows.</li> <li>Learning about hibernation and nocturnal animals.</li> <li>Looking at changes from Autumn to Winter.</li> <li>Science – ice melting, habitats, how to animals keep warm in Winter.</li> <li>Creating bird feeds.</li> <li>What does a jungle look like?</li> <li>Finding out about other countries in the world, how do others live?</li> </ul>	Texts of the Week  Owl Babies, The Gruffalo's Child, How to Catch a star, Jack Frost, Peace at Last, One Snowy Night, Night Monkey Day Monkey, The Magical Snow Garden, Whoever's Heard of a Hibernating Pig, Don't Hog the Hedge, Fiction/nonfiction books.
