Amazing Animals

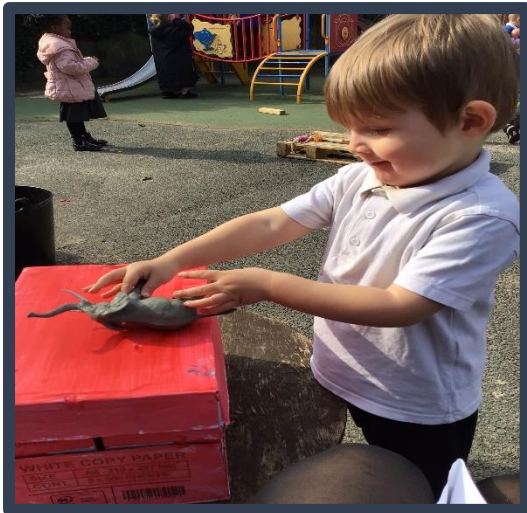

In Maths we have been doing lots of number songs, our favourite at the minute being 5 hot cross buns. We have been working with numbers 1-3 and using positional language to describe objects.

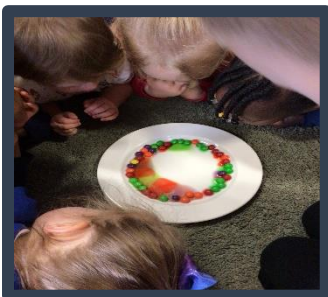
We dressed in red to raise funds for Comic Relief #Love #Generosity
