<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce Zones of Regulation • Beginning to be interested in one another’s play. • Show more confidence in new social situations. 	<p><u>Communication and Language</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listens to and enjoys rhythmic patterns in rhymes and stories • Circle time – Sharing weekend news. • Understand simple questions. • Follow instructions. • Lots of singing and rhyme. • Follow two step simple instruction • Join in with a small group. 	<p><u>Physical Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop self-care skills. Expect children to try and put on their own coat, shoes, use a toilet and use a fork and/or spoon for eating. • Practise on bikes and scooters. • Playdough tools, water and sand tools, scooping, patting and pouring. • Coker rolling, cars through paint, paint rollers etc. • Fit the pieces of a puzzle together. • Make snips in paper.
<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning new rhymes and predicting rhyme in well-known books. Highlighting alliteration in books. • Continuing with body percussion and environmental sounds. • Listen to simple stories and understand what is happening with the help of pictures. • Joins in with repeated refrains. 	<p><u>Expressive Arts and Design</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play circle games that require teamwork and cooperation e.g Parachute, Duck duck goose. • Learn about the changes that happen through Autumn. • Make marks intentionally. • Show attention to sound and music. 	<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to learn number names through songs and counting for the register, children in a line. • 1,2,3 characters in many of the fairy tales. • Complete inset puzzles. • Categorise objects according to its properties e.g size, shape.
<p><u>Understanding the World</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn about the changes through Autumn • Learn about the different festivals celebrated: Diwali, Bonfire, Christmas. 	<p><u>Texts of the Week</u></p> <p>The Gruffalo, The Snail and the Whale, The Smartest Giant, Stick Man, Room on the Broom, Three Billy Goats Gruff, The Three Little Pigs, Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Little Red Hen, Jack and the Beanstalk, The Gingerbread Man, Christmas Story.</p>
