<u>English</u>	<u>Maths</u>	<u>Science</u>
As readers, we will be learning to use VIPERS to explore a text. We will be answering questions by retrieving the answers from a text and using the text and illustrations to make predictions. As writers, this half term our book is Somebody Swallowed Stanley. We will be learning about the dangers in our oceans and writing a letter about the importance of saving the wildlife.	As mathematicians, we will be learning about different kinds of measurement. We will learn how to measure length and height as well as weight and volume. Later in the term we will be learning about multiplication and division. We will learn to count in 2s, 5s and 10s and we will begin to make arrays to answer questions.	As Scientists, we will be exploring the use of everyday materials. We will be working scientifically to find out which are the best materials to keep objects dry. We will make predictions, learn how to make careful observations over time and we will learn how to record the data from our investigations.
