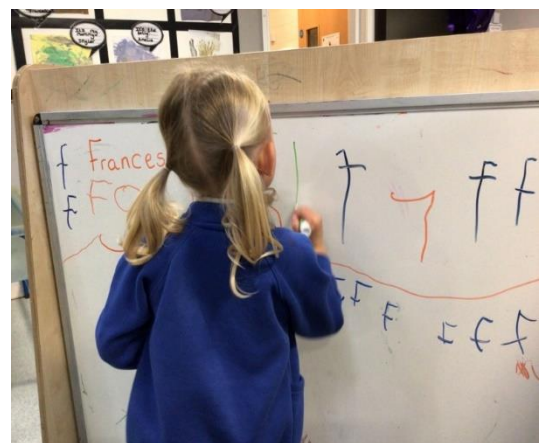
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We have read the story 'My 5 senses' from this we explored different objects and food.
