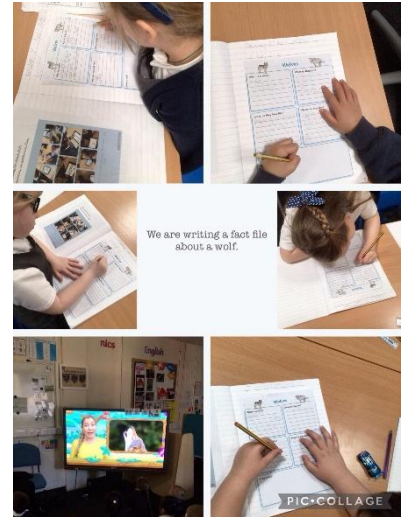

What a fantastic Spring term we have had together learning and growing realising ‘With God, all things are possible’.

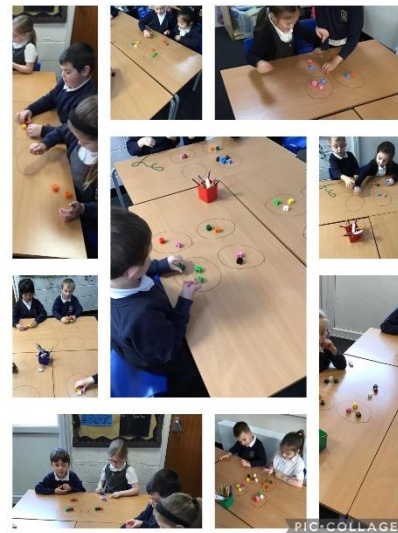
English

In English, we have loved our book ‘Little Red’. We have worked hard identifying adjectives and nouns and applying these to our writing. We have learnt the features of a fact file and wrote our own one on Wolves. We have had some amazing writing!



Mathematics

We have covered lots of maths in this term! We have looked at place value, addition and subtraction and length and height. We have been learning different strategies to help us work out the answers to some 2-digit problems. We have been learning how to use a ruler correctly and had lots of fun measuring different items in the classroom.



RE

Our focus for this half term has been ‘How and why Christians celebrate Easter?’ We have explored the Easter Story and made links with new life and new beginnings. We have also reflected on the role of Jesus and why he is important to Christians.

Science

We have loved enjoyed our Everyday Materials topic. We have thought about a range of materials and applied this to practical learning. Not only can we identify and name different materials we can also sort materials into properties. We have had the opportunity to test materials and have enjoyed the practical hands-on experience- especially finding the best kind of material for a shelter for Ted the Teddy Bear. We also visited the Hive in Bolton which provided us with lots of science links- we loved doing the bug hunt and identifying plants.



History

In history, Year One learnt about the Great Fire of London. We have remembered lots of fantastic key vocabulary such as bakery, Pudding Lane and Samuel Pepes. The children are now confident in describing this historical event and we looked at the changes made to London after the fire. We have also then linked this to our DT subject freestanding structures and enjoyed designing and creating our own Tudor houses.
