English

Mathematics

We have covered lots of maths in this term! We have looked at place value, addition and subtraction and length and height. We have identified 3D shapes and their properties and looked at finding half and quarters of fractions in different ways.

RE

Our focus for this half term has been all about Judaism. The children have learnt lots about how Jewish people celebrate their religion. We also got to celebrate ‘Spirituality Day’. The children re-enacted Jesus’ healing stories, made their own methodist art work and carried out our own mindfulness walk outside.





Science

We have learnt all about plants and their parts this term as well as different types of trees. The children even got to plant their own sunflower and tomato seeds into pots and take these home. As well as all this exciting learning, we learnt about different fruits and vegetables and got to do some fruit tasting! Yum!

History

In history, Year One have been learning about Significant People including Neil Armstrong and Mae Jamison. The children have really enjoyed learning about the first man on the moon and making great comparisons between the important figures!

Geography
