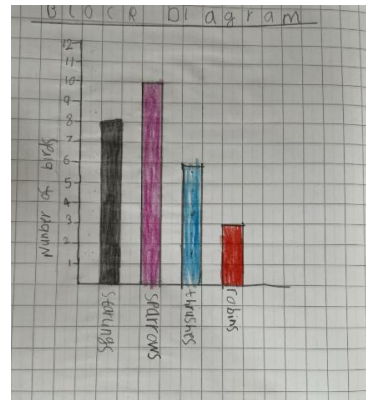
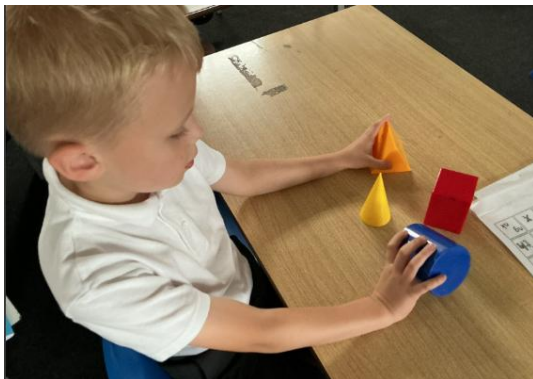
What a year we have had in Year 2. Summer Term has been filled with learning and laughter!

English

In English, we have used our book as a hook write some fantastic fact files about koalas and other Australian animals. We also completed our senses poetry and 18 of our children had their work selected for publication. How amazing!

Mathematics

In Maths, we have learned to tell the time within 5 minute intervals. We have explored 3D shapes and their properties and last week we revisited statistics by collecting data about school dinners and presenting this as a block diagram.



Science

In Science, we learned all about plants and what they need to grow and survive. We dissected seeds to find out what was inside. The children were excellent at spotting the seed embryo. We conducted an experiment in which we planted seeds and observed how they grew over a number of weeks. We removed one thing they needed from each plant such as soil, light and water and we gave one plant everything it needed.



Art and Design

In Art this term, children created designs in their sketch books inspired by existing batik artwork. They transferred these designs onto old T-shirts and used glue and fabric dye to create lots of different patterns.



PE

In PE this term, children have developed their attacking and defending skills through a range of team games. They particularly enjoyed playing treasure island and thinking of tactics to make sure their team got the most treasure. They also enjoyed a sunny sports day and everyone participated well.
