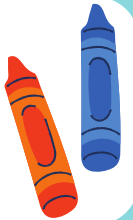

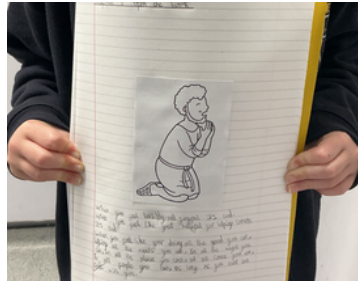


Good Work Awards

Each week we have a different focus for our Epworth Worship.

A film is shared between our family of Trust schools - a different film being produced each week by a different school. It is lovely to see the children of our Trust taking a lead in a different aspect of worship.

This week, we looked at how sometimes, we run away from our past because it hurts or reminds us of our mistakes. But these mistakes are our guiding light. Children were encouraged to look out for someone at school or someone at home who's made a mistake and doesn't know how to put it right. We discussed what we can say to help their hearts heal and feel full again. The children were challenged to use words, actions or perhaps a picture to help them to feel like they are still loved and valued.



Westleigh Worship

In this week's whole school worship, we focused on how Christians believe that Jesus offers 'life in all its fullness'. We also looked at how the Bible reminds people again and again that human beings are meant to be together, to work together, to be together in community.

Ecclesiastes Chapter 4 talks of how you are better off to have a friend than to be all alone, because then you will get more enjoyment out of what you earn. If you fall, your friend can help you up. But if you fall without having a friend nearby, you are really in trouble.... As the saying goes, "A rope made from three strands of cord is hard to break." The children were able to discuss the meaning of this quote.
