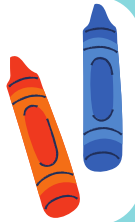

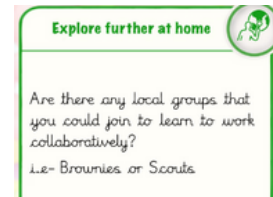


Each week we have a different focus for our Epworth Worship.
