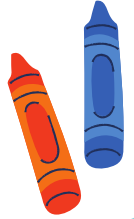

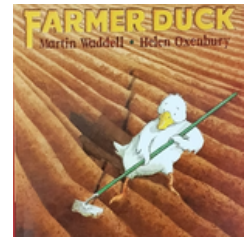
Well done for keeping your classroom tidy. Keep up the good work!

I was so pleased with Fraser's painting skills when I visited Nursery this week. I loved his excitement and skills as he painted his duck with Mrs Horrocks.

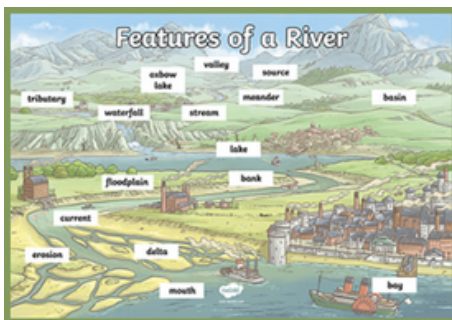


## Good Work Awards

# Safeguarding Our Children



Operation Encompass is a police and education early information sharing partnership enabling schools to offer immediate support for children and young people experiencing domestic abuse. Information is shared by the police with a school's trained Key Adult (DSL) prior to the start of the next school day after officers have attended a domestic abuse incident thus enabling appropriate support to be given, dependent upon the needs and wishes of the child. Operation Encompass aims to mitigate this harm by enabling immediate support, making a child's day better and giving them a better tomorrow. Further information can be found at:
