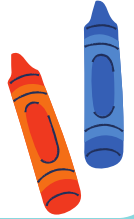

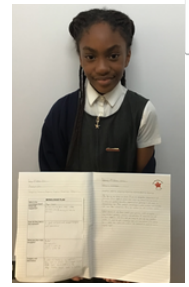
Winner: Year 3
