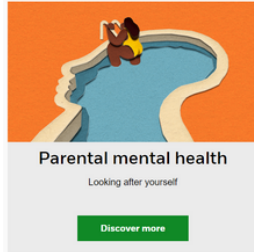




Safeguarding Our Children
