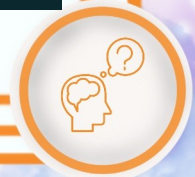
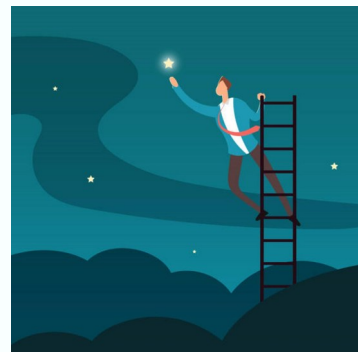
Bible verse of the week
