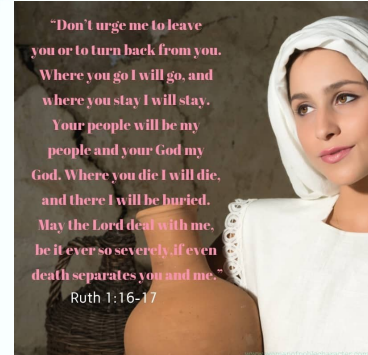

Either on your own or with a buddy, think of all the different ways respect can be seen, felt or heard in these different settings and with these different groups of people.

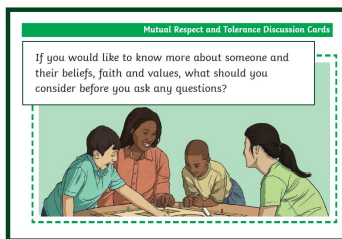
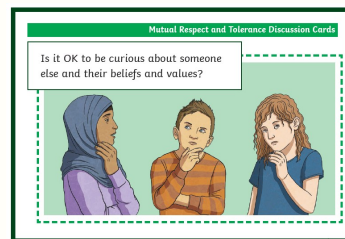
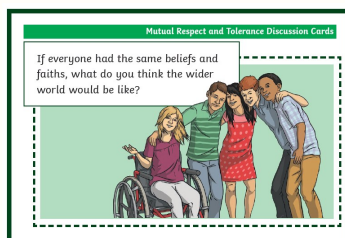
