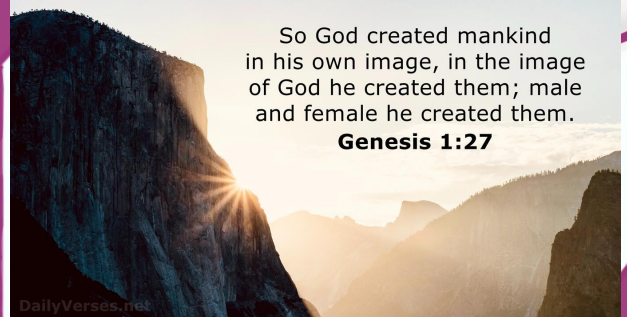

Creativity and the Spiritual



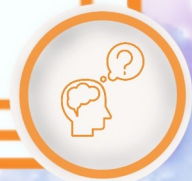
So God created mankind

This week's activity



- **Prayer or Worship Art:** Children draw or paint how they feel during prayer or worship, using colors or symbols to express joy, peace, or gratitude.
- **Sacred Music Exploration:** Children create rhythms, melodies, or short "prayer songs" inspired by worship music, exploring how sound connects them to God.
- **Storytelling from Scripture:** Children retell a scripture story creatively—through drawings, comics, or short plays—to understand and express its spiritual message.

Explore further at home



- **Gratitude Art Collage:** Cut, draw, or glue pictures of things you're thankful for to make a colorful collage, reflecting on how gratitude inspires creativity.
- **Nature Listening Walk:** Take a quiet walk, notice sounds and sights, then draw, write, or tell a story inspired by what you experienced.
- **Light in a Jar:** Decorate a jar with tissue paper and place a light inside, thinking about your own "inner light" and what makes you shine.
