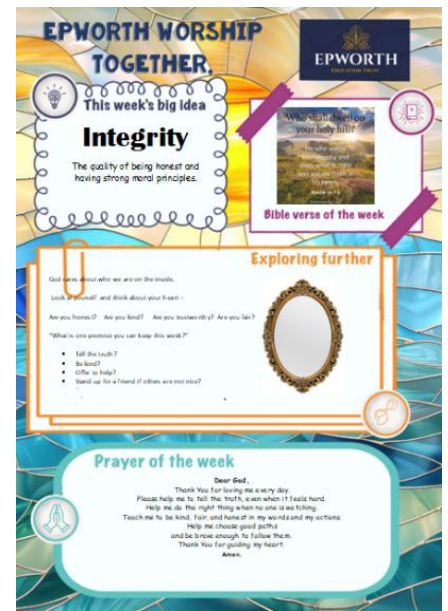
Epworth Worship Together
