Y2 did an amazing job in their class assembly focusing on our class Christian value generosity.



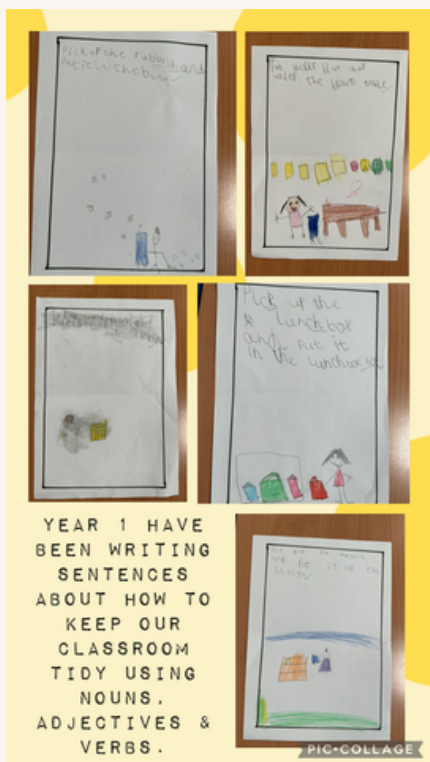
Y2 carefully traced their designs onto fabric, used glue to make their own batik designs and used paint to finish it off.
