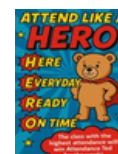
Our School Vision :

Reception



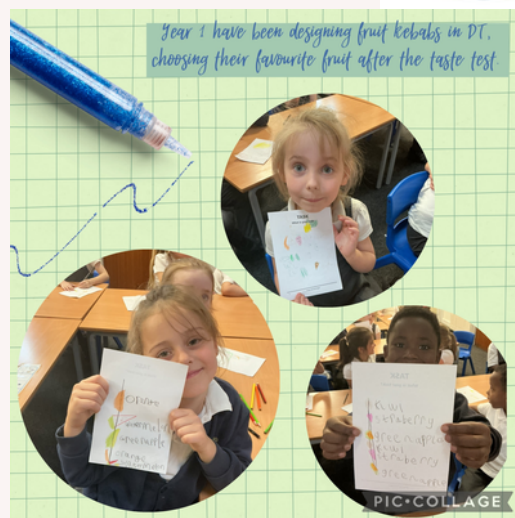

Y2

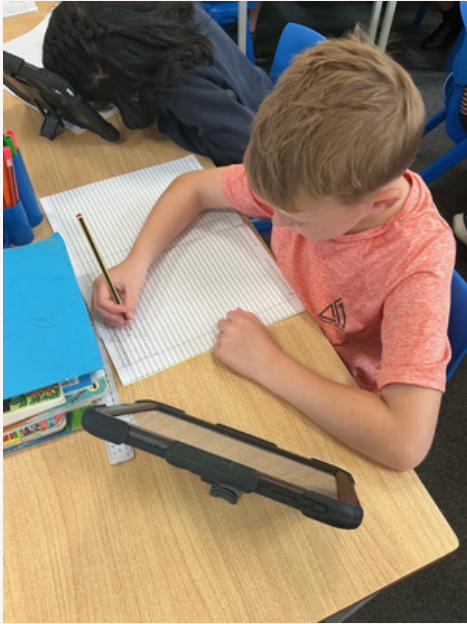


In computing Year 2 have extracted information from a 2Connect file to make a published fact file on The United Kingdom.

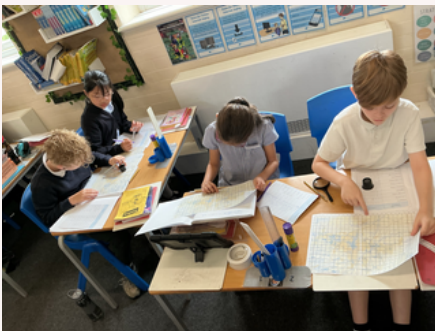


Y5
