#### **COVID Updates**

- From Tuesday 14 December, a new national approach to daily testing for contacts of COVID-19 is being introduced (including until the end of this term). All adults who are fully vaccinated and children aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 – whether Omicron or not – should take a lateral flow device (LFD) test every day for 7 days instead of self-isolating. Daily testing by close contacts will help to slow the spread of COVID-19.
- Please see any 'Warn to inform' letters that may have been sent to your child and act upon advice given in regards to testing this will help to keep our Westleigh family safe.
- The COVID risk assessment in school has been updated regarding government guidance this week. If you are visiting school for any reason face masks must be worn.
- Children do not need to wear face masks, however adults in school will do so when walking around school, but not in the classrooms.
- If your child displays any COVID symptoms then please book them in for a PCR test, this will help to keep our school community safe.
