# **COVID Updates**

- If you are visiting school for any reason face masks must be worn.

- If your child displays any COVID symptoms then please book them in for a PCR test, this will help to keep our school community safe. A lateral flow test is not suitable if your child is unwell.
- Please inform school immediately if any child or member of a child's household tests positive for COVID and whether it is the Omicron variant or if a child has had contact with a positive case.


