Overview of the meeting:

Welcome to everyone and thank you for attending today.

Easter Disco – The disco would be held on Thursday 30th March. KS1 and KS2 would be separate like last time. £3 per ticket and children would receive a drink hotdog and crisp or sweets. We may also have a tuck shop this time.

Holidays in term time – Mrs Smyth asked about the recent court case in another authority which had been in the news. She asked where school stood on allowing children with good attendance to have a set amount of holiday absence authorised. Mrs Waterworth explained that school fall in line with Wigan Local Authority and do not authorised holiday in term time. Parents whose child has unauthorised absences may receive a Penalty Notice from the Local Authority.

Reading Shed Update – Mrs Waterworth said that there had been a number of delays with the Reading Shed and getting it ordered and fitted. The money raised at the last Christmas Fayre would be used, however we wanted to ensure we purchased one which would be long lasting. School have one in the Reception Playground and provided it last well in the weather we would be ordering the same one. Mrs Smyth gave a number of a reliable contractor.

Bag packing - Suggestions about raising money by children bag packing was made, however it was felt that this would have to be done out of school time and on the weekends. All agreed staffing this would be difficult.
