Year 6 also had a virtual tour of a Buddhist Temple. They spoke with a Buddhist monk from Sri Lanka, who spoke about his journey into becoming a monk and the daily life of a monk. He then demonstrated a Mantra as a way of focussing their minds and finding inner peace.

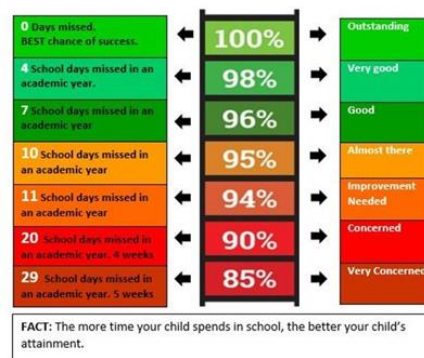
Our children have gained invaluable insight this week through these wider curriculum experiences.
