## English

**As readers**, we will be reading and analysing the book 'Stitch Head' by Guy Bass. We will continue to practise our Reading VIPERS skills through answering a range of comprehension questions.

**As writers**, this half term our book is 'Stitch Head' by Guy Bass. We will be writing a range of genres linked to this text including newspaper reports, persuasive arguments and a mystery narrative.

## Maths

**As mathematicians**, we will be focusing on the topics of decimals, measurement and statistics. We will learn how to estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence. We will also learn how to measure time including how to convert time between minutes and hours and convert between analogue and digital. We will interpret and present data using bar charts, line graphs, tables and pictograms.

## Religious Education

Our RE focus question is 'Where, how and why do people pray?'

**Spiritual**: We will explore and reflect on the pupils own experience of prayer.

**Moral**: We will consider the morality of people's prayers.

**Social**: We will explore the practice and function of prayer in different religious traditions.

**Cultural**: We will explore how prayer is used in different cultures and religious traditions.

## Science

**As Scientists**, we will be investigating states of matter. We will compare and group materials together identifying solids, liquids and gases. We will observe changing states using temperature and identify and describe the stages of the water cycle. We will also be learning about electricity where we will learn how to create simple electrical circuits.

## History

**As Historians**, we will be studying the lives of the Ancient Greeks and learn about their achievements. We will consider their influence on the western world.

## Geography

**As Geographers**, we will be studying the country of Greece, linking to our Ancient Greece topic. We will be learning about Greece's geographical and human features and we will compare and contrast Greece to the UK.

**In Computing**, we will be hardware investigators. We will investigate the different parts of a computer and will produce a leaflet on Purple Mash to explain these parts. We will also learn how to create music using the tools on Purple Mash.
