English

As readers, we will be discussing the events that happen in 'The Hideaway' and 'The Boy in The Tower,' and focussing on our inference skills of using clues to find answers about the characters, situations and resolutions.

As writers, this half term our books are Macbeth, The Jabberwocky and The Boy In The Tower. We will explore the language used by Shakespeare in one of his most famous literary pieces and identify the themes of power and betrayal through our writing. We will create recounts of the famous battle, diary entries from Lady Macbeth, and some poetry from the witches to further improve our creative writing skills. We'll also create our own nonsense poems and narrative about monsters invading.
