In English, we have been exploring the books: Great Expectations and Room 13. These are two very different genres and we have had so much fun dissecting the characters.

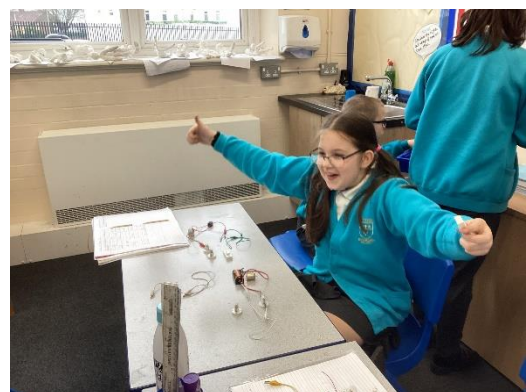
A wedding table appeared at the beginning of spring and we had to use our inference skills to work out what had happened!
