- **Wednesday 4th January** – Children return to school

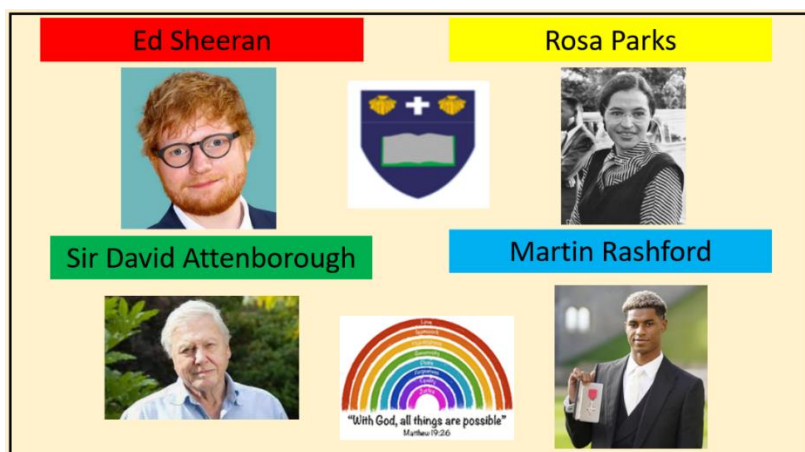

This term in our SCARF lessons, we are going to be thinking about relationships. About the different types of relationships in our lives. About how we should treat other people and how we should expect to be treated.

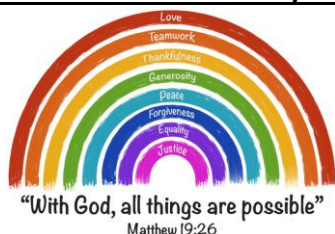
