Worship



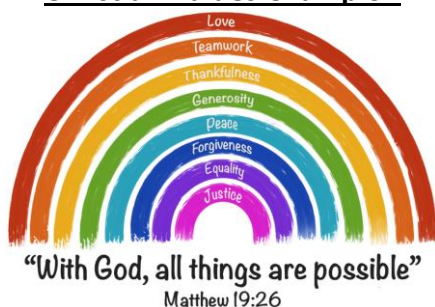
