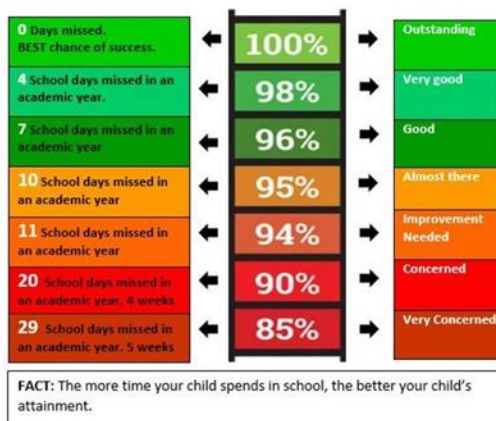

Worship



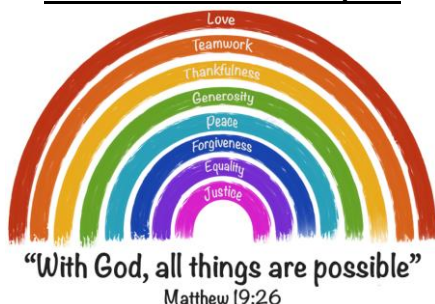
