We are still taking donations of Christmas jumpers if anybody has any that they would like to donate.

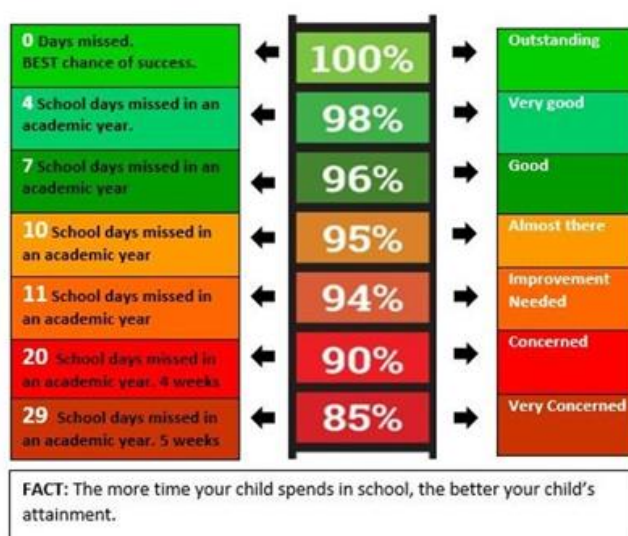

**'Find your own way. You don't have to follow the crowd.'**

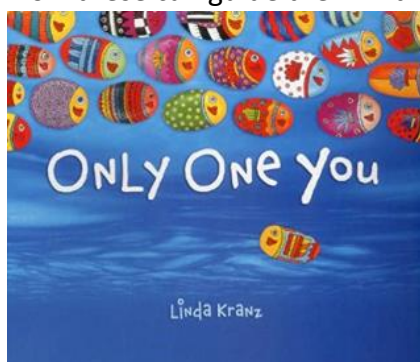
**'Know when to speak; know when to listen.'**
