## Weekly Newsletter: WC 12<sup>th</sup> December










Well done to Year 3 who get to spin the attendance wheel this afternoon for a special reward next week!

#### <u>Worship</u>

This week in worship we have been exploring Advent. Advent is an important part of the Christian calendar - it means 'coming' and it's the period before Christmas, which celebrates the birth of Jesus. It is all about preparing for Christmas Day. Advent starts on the Sunday nearest to 30 November. So in

2022, it started on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> November and will run until Saturday 24th December. We have explored why Christians celebrate Christmas as Christianity focuses on the life and teachings of Jesus Christ, who Christians believe to be the Son of God. Christmas celebrates Jesus' birth so the Advent period reminds Christians to remember and prepare for those celebrations. We have also discussed the meaning of the Advent wreath, which symbolises the passage of the four weeks of Advent in the liturgical calendar. We discussed Christingles, which Y3 and Y1, made with Reverend Catherine last week during a special worship.


