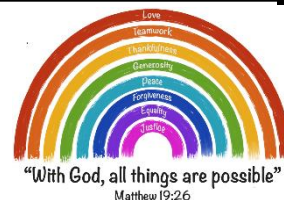




Westleigh Methodist Primary School

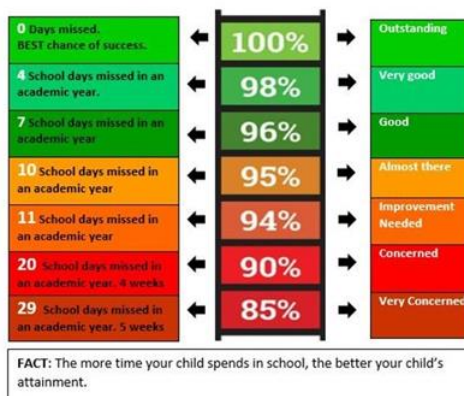

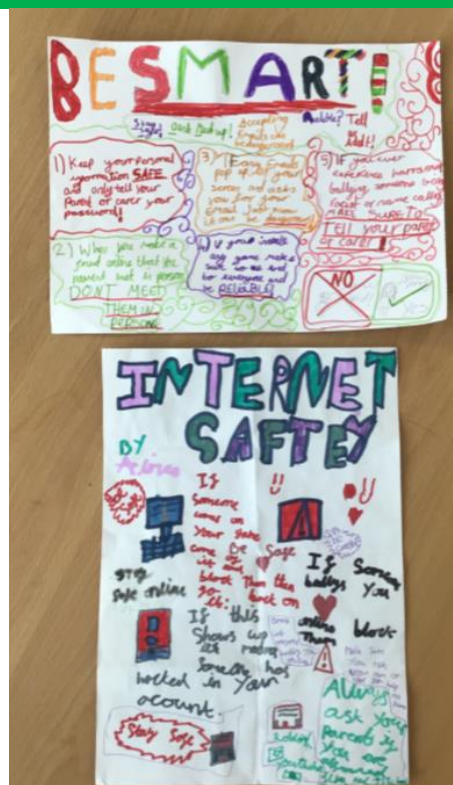
Well done Year 6 this week on winning the highest attendance.
