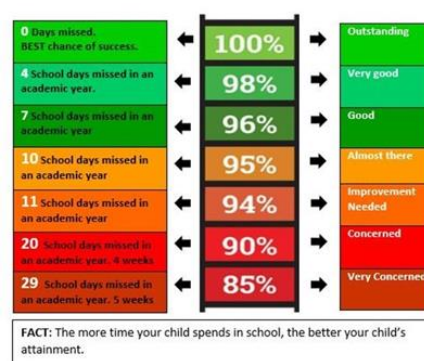
Year 6 are very excited this morning leaving for a fun-filled trip to Rock and River to take part in a range of exciting team building and water activities.

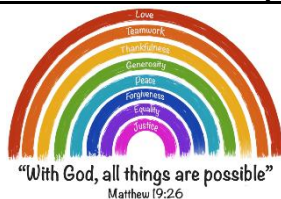
