## Weekly Newsletter: WC 19th June



We were visited this week by Becca from 'All We Can'. We are a partner school for the Methodist charity 'All We Can'. All We Can is an international development and emergency relief organisation. All We Can helps find solutions to poverty by engaging with local people and organisations in some of the world's poorest communities to end the suffering caused by inequality and injustice. Becca explored the statement 'every person's potential fulfilled', this is the mission of the charity. Becca led on whole school worship to allow the children to explore the meaning of this mission. The children discussed what their own potential means. Becca then visited each class to lead a workshop exploring what partnering with someone or a community looks like and why the way we do partnership is as important as the outcomes. The children gained a real insight into listening to our communities and their needs and what they think the problems and solutions are to reach their own potential. The children were engaged in activities which emphasised the importance of listening to others and others needs and not making assumptions. They then linked this is listening to our communities and their needs.- Please speak with your children to ask them all about the visit and workshops and what they learnt and what they think their potential is, 'With God, All Things are Possible – Matthew 19:26'.



On Tuesday, Year 2 had a very special visitor from Bolton Mosque. Imam came to teach us all about the life of a practicing Muslim. He began by welcoming us with a prayer and showing us how Muslims call to prayer each morning. He showed us a prayer mat and the Quran. Did you know that a Quran has over 800 pages? We also looked closely at his prayer beads and he modelled how they are used. We learnt so much about the Islamic faith during this afternoon session. We would like to thank Imam and Bolton Mosque for visiting us.


