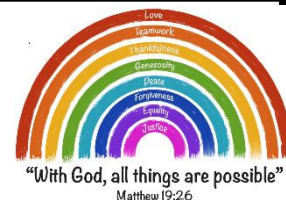




Westleigh Methodist Primary School

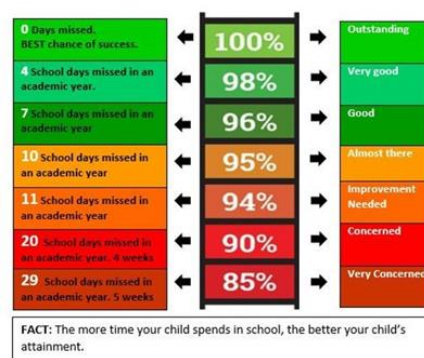

During worship we have discussed the news story all about 13 year old Max Woosey – also known as the ‘Boy in the Tent’, who has recently set a Guinness World Record for the most money raised by camping. Inspired by a family friend, the young teenager has raised over £750,000 for North Devon Hospice. Max has spent every night in a tent since he began his challenge three years ago in the garden of his home in Devon. We discussed how challenging this would be for Max and how he would overcome these obstacles. We linked it to what challenges we have or may face within our own lives and what we can do to overcome these challenges. The children were also really good at thinking of ways to support Max and Devon Hospice. We decided that there are many ways we can show our support and raise awareness of things that are important to us. By challenging ourselves and pushing our limits, we can accomplish incredible things.

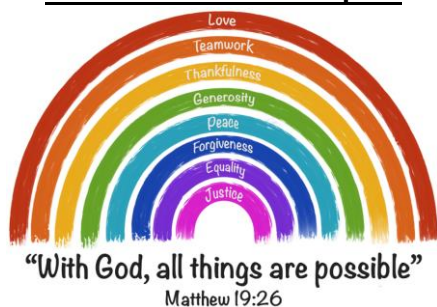
